



Ecclesall Primary School Uniform Policy September 2018

Ecclesall Primary School has a standardised Dress Code.

Children should adhere to the following when attending school:

(These can be worn with or without the school logo)

- School sweatshirts – royal blue
- Polo shirts – royal blue or white
- Dark trousers of school uniform type grey or black.
- Dark coloured skirts/dresses of school uniform type preferred, but any dark skirt/dress is acceptable.
- Dark coloured shoes, Velcro type fastenings would be advisable for Reception children.
- Plain dark footwear

Warm Weather Options

- School type summer dresses are preferred (e.g. gingham style dresses) but any suitable sleeved dress is acceptable.
- Dark school type shorts, but any dark coloured shorts are acceptable.

The school, Governing Body and Ecclesall Parents Teachers and Friends Association (EPTFA) will arrange events where second hand items can be purchased throughout the year. Any parent that has concerns regarding the affordability of uniform items can talk in confidence to the Head Teacher.

Ethnic/Religious Dress

In line with the schools Equality Policy any form of ethnic or religious dress are acceptable, please consult with the Head Teacher or Governing Body with any concerns you may have.

Jewellery

We would prefer jewellery not to be worn at school. As well as not being part of the school uniform policy there are serious safety risks to the wearing of jewellery especially when children are playing outside or partaking in sport.

Where your child has pierced ears, plain stud earrings are acceptable, but these may be required to be taped over during PE.

Watches are also allowed but please make sure they are not valuable and where possible labelled with your child's name.

Nail varnish and make-up should not be worn.

Clothing for PE

A PE kit with white T-shirt, shorts, joggers, hoody, pumps or trainers needs to be in school every day.

Reception children do not need a PE kit. You may bring a white T-shirt to keep in their draw if required.

Labelling of Clothes

Please label all your child's clothes and shoes clearly as this helps your child identify their sweatshirt amongst all the others and reduce the size of the lost property box!
