

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: 2 Term: Autumn 1

English:

- Writing sentences about ourselves. Focusing on using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces.
- Writing riddles about woodland animals. Identifying and using verbs and adverbs.
- Writing a recount in the form of a diary entry of a person who witnessed the Great Fire of London. Focusing on writing in the past tense, using time adverbials and conjunctions.

Computing:

- Developing basic computing skills (typing and file management)
- Introduction to Scratch and basic features covered in Y2.

PE:

- Throwing and catching accurately using different passes.
- Gymnastics- balancing and different ways to travel.

Maths:

Place Value

- Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
- Partition 2-digit numbers in to tens and ones.
- Compare and order objects and numbers.

Addition and subtraction

- Number bonds to 20
- Related number facts
- Add and subtract tens and ones from 2-digit numbers
- Add three 1 digit numbers

Music:

- Singing harvest songs
- Composing their own piece of music of their interpretation of the Great Fire of London.

Art & DT:

- Collage and watercolour linked to animals and their habitats

RE:

- Judaism – Rosh Hashanah celebration.
- Hinduism – Diwali celebration.

- Guided reading books to be returned every Tuesday

- Growth Mindset.
- Living things and their habitats.
