This half-term our topic is; 'Colour and celebrations around the world'

Literacy

Our big book this week is "Handa's Surprise". We will be reading the book as a class and talking about the story. Within writing we will begin to write about our celebration photos. Please make sure your child's class teacher has their celebration photo ready for writing.

We will be introducing some new phonemes this week v/w/x/y and thinking of words that start with these sounds. We will be blending words with these phonemes and segmenting them together when reading. We will be reading all of the phase 2 ticky words : I, no, go, into, the and to.

Mathematics

Our focus for maths this week is to compare objects by their length, weight and size and put them in the correct order. The language we will be introducing is ; bigger, smaller, biggest, smallest, longer, longest, heaviest and lightest.

Understanding the World

We will be reflecting on a celebration that some people took part in last week, Bonfire Night! We will be answering the children's questions : "How do fireworks work? Why is there a pretend person on the fire?"
