

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: Reception Term: Sp1-Once Upon A Time.

Prime Area: Communication & Language

- Uses story language to imagine and recreate roles from traditional tales.
- Builds up vocabulary related to what materials are made of and their uses.
- Listens to stories without pictures or prompts.
- Develop story language during play.
- Shows increased attention during carpet time.

Prime Area: Personal Social and Emotional Development

- Returns to school confidently and able to speak to other about their interests and opinions.
- Talking confidently to others about what they did in the holidays.
- Remembers classroom rules and expectations of being in school.
- Ask other children questions about their holiday.

Prime Area: Physical Development: Moving and Handling

- Holds a pencil near point between first two fingers and thumb.
- Traveling in a variety of different ways with confidence.
- Shows control when balancing.

Prime Area: Physical Development: Health and Self Care

- Eats a healthy range of foodstuffs.
- Shows understanding of the need for safety when tackling new challenges.

Literacy: Reading

- Recap previously learnt digraphs
- Introduce phase 3 sounds
- To begin to read tricky words *he / she / we / be / me / was / my / you / they / are / all*

Numeracy

- Explore addition and subtraction within 15.
- Recognise numbers to 20.
- Order numbers to 15.
- Exploring shapes and their properties.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Explore how to make loud and quiet noises using equipment.
- Observational drawings of teddy bears.
- Introduce story language when in the role play area.

Dates

- Bring your favourite teddy bear to school throughout the week beginning 27th January 2020.

Literacy: Writing

- Write tricky words *to/the/go/no/into* in sentences.
- To recount tradition stories in different ways e.g The Three Little Pigs story map.
- To write simple sentences.

Understanding the World

- Similarities and differences of objects and materials.
- Children talk confidently to the class about why their teddy bear is special.
- Explore how materials change.

Reminders

- Gloves, scarf, wellies and coats needed in cold weather.
- Remember to have your PE kits in school on a Friday.
