

Week Beginning December 9th
This half-term our topic is;

Literacy

This week we will be enjoying a range of stories, poetry and rhymes related to Christmas.

In phonics we will be introducing 3 new digraphs ; sh, ch and th. A digraph is where two letters make one sound. We will also practise all key words learned so far. We will be practising the skills of blending sounds to read and segmenting to spell, and playing lots of games to help us including our 'full-circle' game. We will be continuing to write our simple sentences, 'I am.... Put in a.... Can I get a...?'

Mathematics

We will be learning vocabulary linked to sequencing our day. The stars words for this week are; first, after, next, before and last. We will be ordering the events that we do in the morning, afternoon and evening.

Understanding the world

We will be talking about how Christmas is celebrated around the world and other traditions that people take part in. We will be thinking of the similarities and differences between ourselves and others.
