Word	Definition
The Blitz	bombing raids against cities during World War II
evacuation	many children living in big cities and towns were moved temporarily from their homes to places considered safer (usually out in the countryside)
axis	countries on Germany's side of the war
allies	countries on the British side of the war
propaganda	information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause or point of view
air raid	an attack in which bombs are dropped from aircraft on to a ground target.
rations	a fixed amount of food and other goods officially allowed to each person
liberate	to free
siren	a loud signal to alert people of bombings
