Where is Mrs Biggs?



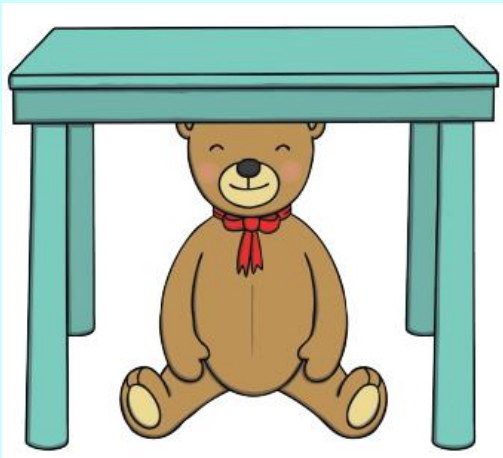
Mrs Biggs is next to her cute dog ready to play catch!

Task

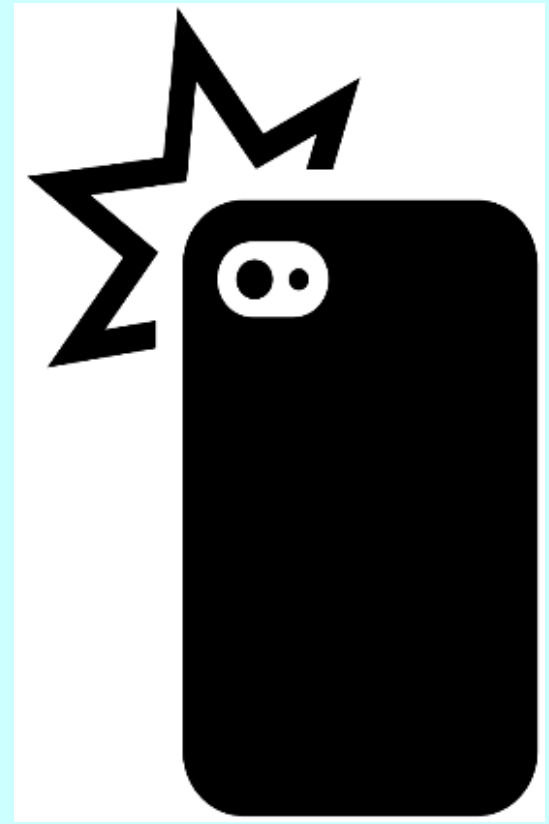
This activity is like the one you did earlier on in Y3!

The teddy is under the table.

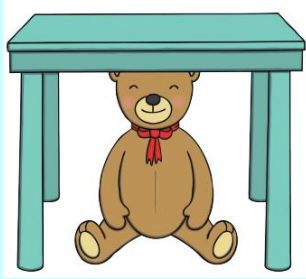


(If you can't take a picture,

1. Include an expanded noun phrase to describe the objects.

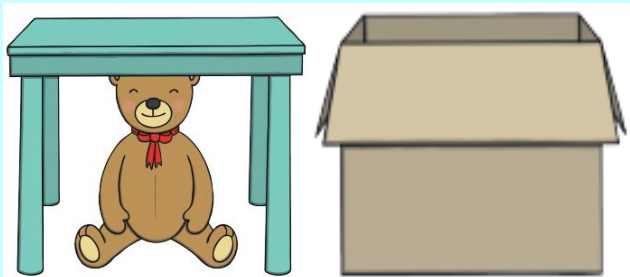
Example:
