Subject	Task/Activity	Easier/Harder	Notes
Maths 1 (Recap)	Complete 2x countdowns that can be found on the website (one calculation and one concept)	Easier: Complete addition and subtraction calculations only. Harder: Create your own questions for your parents using the same concepts	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the questions into your home learning book.
Maths 2 (new learning)	<p>Task 1: Complete White Rose Maths home learning – Summer Term – Week 2 – Lesson 2 Order Lengths. There is a 10min video to watch and then an activity to complete.</p> <p>Task 2: Complete White Rose Maths home learning – Summer Term – Week 2 – Lesson 3 Four Operations with length. There is a 10min video to watch and then an activity to complete.</p> <p>Task 3: Complete White Rose Maths home learning – Summer Term – Week 2 – Lesson 4 Problem Solving. There is a 10min video to watch and then an activity to complete.</p>	<p>Easier: Complete Task 1 only. Explain your answers verbally to a parent/sibling. Can you ask/write some similar questions for them?</p> <p>Harder: Complete Task 1, 2 and 3. Can you write some similar questions for a sibling/parent to answer?</p>	If you don't have access to a printer, just write the answers into your home learning book. (don't worry about copying all of the long-worded questions too!)
Reading	<p>Task 1: Mr Snuggles Gets Lost</p> <p>Task 2: Sasha's Diary</p>	<p>Easier: Complete task 1. You could have a read through task 2 with an adult if someone is available to help you.</p> <p>Harder: Complete tasks 1 and 2.</p>	If you don't have access to a printer, just write the title of the comprehension and the answers into your home learning book.

Spelling	Recapping on common exception words and words with the r phoneme spelt wr.	Easier – Choose 5 or 10 of the common exception words to focus on and no challenges. Harder – Learn all the spellings, including the ones from task 2 and both challenges.	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the words/ table into your home learning book.
Writing	Write an acrostic poem	Easier – Write a simple poem with a few words in each line. Harder – Try to use similes and/ or rhyming words in your poem.	It is your choice to decide how to display your poem. You can use your home learning book or a more imaginative way if you like!
Topic 1	Life cycle of an apple tree-	Easier – Cut and order the life cycle of an apple tree, draw pictures with each stage. Harder – What does the seed/plant need at each stage to grow?	If you don't have access to a computer, draw the templates by hand into your home learning book.
Topic 2	Life cycle of a plant	Easier – Read statements about plant lifecycles and order them, copy onto the flower template. Harder – Complete the Bitesize quiz. Create a diary entry for the seeds grown in week 1.
