3. Inside school you will see yellow tape and new signs, these are to remind you to stay away from others.

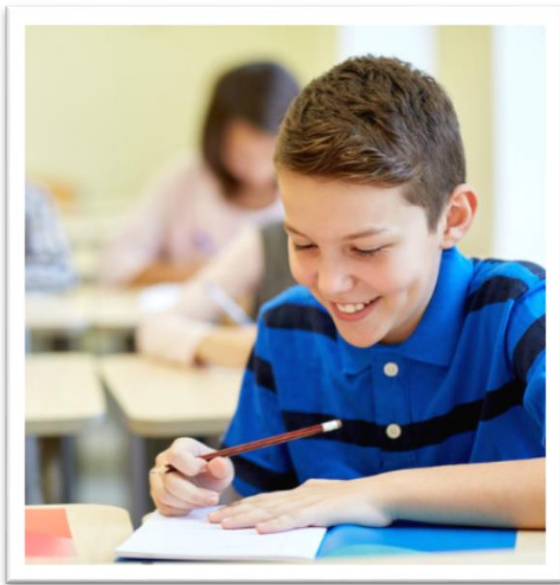


4. The classrooms will look a bit different because Mr Moffatt has spread the tables out.

We are really looking forward to seeing you soon!

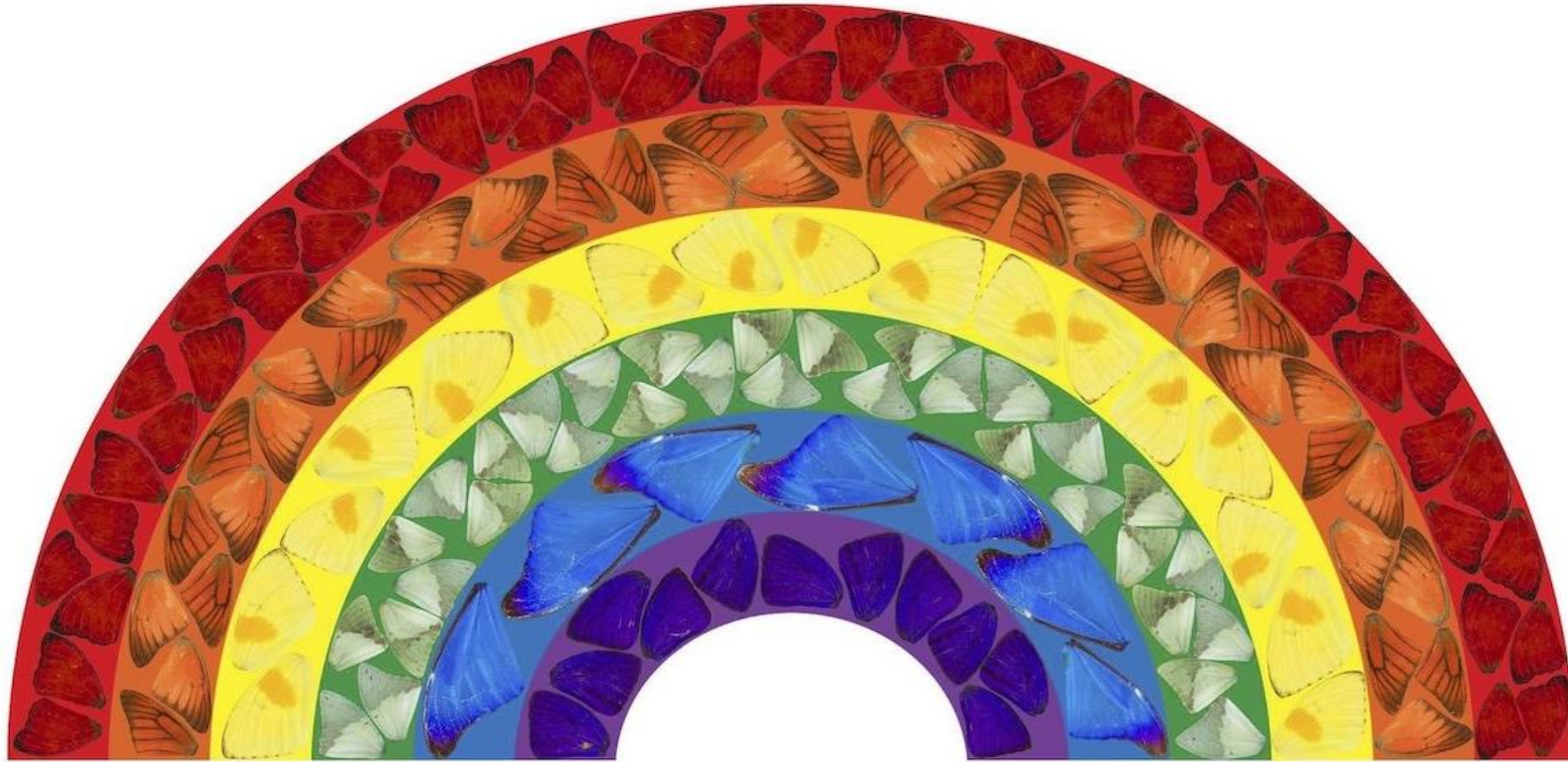




We will all make sure you have a great time!
