Subject	Task/Activity	Easier/Harder	Notes
Maths 1 (Recap)	Complete 2x countdowns that can be found on the website (one calculation and one concept)	Easier: Complete addition and subtraction calculations only. Harder: Create your own questions for your parents using the same concepts.	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the questions into your home learning book.
Maths 2 (new learning)	Task 1: Directions – Can you write directions for the dog to reach the bone? Challenge: Can you write instructions for the dog to reach the bone in a different way? How many different ways can you find? Task 2 – Challenge – Directions: Follow the instructions to find where the treasure is.	Easier: Complete one route for the dog to the bone. Harder: Complete as many routes to the bone as you can. Check with a sibling/parent.	Remember to think about which way the dog/ship is facing to start off!
Reading	Task 1: A Space Adventure (story) Task 2: Space Adventure (poem)	Easier: Complete task 1. You could have a read through task 2 with an adult if someone is available to help you. Harder: Complete tasks 1 and 2.	If you don't have access to a printer, just write the title of the comprehension and the answers into your home learning book.
Spelling	Task 1: Recapping on common exception words Task 2: Recapping on adding the suffixes –ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y	Easier – Choose 5 or 10 of the common exception words to focus on and no challenges. Harder – Learn all the spellings, including some from task 2 and both challenges.	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the words/table into your home learning book.
Writing	Continue the story of Jacob and Oscar in reading task 1 – A Space Adventure.	Easier – Use a variety of conjunctions, punctuation and interesting vocabulary.	You can write your story in your home learning book.

		Harder – Use the sentence openers sheet to help you to start your sentences in different ways.	
Topic 1	Task 1: Colour mix and paint in the style of Vincent Van Gogh	Easier: Develop a range of art techniques to create the Sunflower painting inspired by Van Gogh Harder: What adjectives can you think of to describe the sunflowers?	This task can be done in your home learning book or you can work outside and take a picture of your work!
