Subject	Task/Activity	Easier/Harder	Notes
Maths 1 (Recap)	Complete 2x countdowns that can be found on the website (one calculation and one concept)	Easier: Complete addition and subtraction calculations only. Harder: Create your own questions for your parents using the same concepts.	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the questions into your home learning book.
Maths 2 (new learning)	Task 1a: Clockwise and anti-clockwise – follow the instructions to turn the arrows and draw them in their new correct direction. Talk through your answers to 'Questions to think about'. Task 1b: Challenge – work as a pair with an adult/sibling, where one person is blindfolded and the other has to give instructions. Try and make it fun – maybe you could be giving directions to find a biscuit/snack/teddy? Task 2 – Challenge – more difficult clockwise and anti-clockwise instructions with two instructions to follow.	Easier: Complete Task 1a and 1b. Adapt 1b so that you use turn right/left if clockwise and anti-clockwise is not secure. Harder: Complete Task 2 as well as 1a and 1b.	Try and link the idea of clockwise and anti-clockwise in relation to telling the time and the direction clock hands move.
Reading	Task 1: The Great White Shark Task 2: Wild Rabbits	Easier: Complete task 1. You could have a read through task 2 with an adult if someone is available to help you. Harder: Complete tasks 1 and 2.	If you don't have access to a printer, just write the title of the comprehension and the answers into your home learning book
Spelling	Task 1: Recapping on common exception words Task 2: Recapping on plurals	Easier – Choose 5 or 10 of the common exception words to focus on and no challenges. Harder – Learn all of the spellings, including some	If you don't have access to a printer, copy the words/table into your home learning book.

Writing	Write your own version of 'We're going on a bear hunt'. What challenges will you encounter on your journey? Use the planning sheet to first plan your bear hunt.	Easier – Choose 3 types of obstacles or weather and pick 2 sounds starting with the same letter to describe it. Harder – Watch Michael Rosen perform 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' (see link below). Can you perform your story in a similar way?	Write your story in your home leaning book. You can draw pictures too to illustrate it.
Topic 1	Eid ul Fitr – Make an Eid silhouette	Easier: Paint a watercolour background. Cut and stick some mosques and minarets to create a skyline. Harder: Cut and stick a moon and star in the sky.	If you don't have access to watercolours, use any other sort of materials eg pencil crayons.
Topic 2	Eid ul Fitr – Henna hand print	Easier: Create an outline of your hand and cut it out. Decorate with patterns using red, brown or orange colours. Harder: What can you recall about how Eid ul Fitr is celebrated from the story? Draw some pictures or write a few sentences.	
Extra	MyMaths Games – Log in as ecclesall – circles and you can access games down the left hand side. Games – Mental Games – Colour By Numbers (Easy option is actually a good standard!)
