

## Spelling w/c 22/6/20

This week we are going to revise 2 of our spelling rules.

### Rule 1

The r sound can be spelt with a wr at the beginning of a word.

For example: write, wrong, wrap, written, wrote.

### Rule 2

The letters ph are to make the f sound in words of more than 2 syllables.

For example: telephone, phonics, geography, dolphin.
