Maths 1	Complete the Maths Countdown	<b>Support</b> - Use My Maths to revise any concepts you are unsure of. - Countdown Answers - Look at the working out. - Fraction Support Cards (from Summer 2 Week 2).	Apples for Q7 - Draw on the lines to show the coordinates you know. Also, (x,y)
Maths 2	<b>Church Builder Project</b> Read the instruction sheet and use the information sheet to plan building and extending a church.	Draw a plan and record the information for 'work to be done now' and 'work to be done in 30 years time'. Include all costs. <b>Extension</b> Try drawing a 3D view as well as a plan (see the information sheet).	You can also carry on with the maths challenges from Summer 2 Week 4.
Topic	<b>Dragon's Den</b> Create a new flavour of ice cream for the company you created last week. What's it called? Draw a design of it with labels. What type of packaging will your ice cream be in?	<b>Extension Ideas</b> - Research ice cream flavours and packaging first. - Draw a labelled cross-section design (imagine the packaging is cut in half so you can see inside of it). - Make the packaging - include the company name, logo and any other relevant information. <b>Support</b> Use the Existing Ice Cream Brands sheet from last week (Summer 2 Week 5) for ideas.	Consider what makes your ice cream unique. What's the unique selling point (USP)?
Reading	<b>Comparing Advertisements</b> Read the four advertisements and answer the two pages of questions.	If you're unsure of a word in the text or in a vocabulary question, look up the meaning in a dictionary or online.	
Writing	<b>Dragon's Den</b> Create a full page magazine/newspaper advertisement to sell your new ice cream flavour. Include persuasive language and features (see the support sheet).	<b>Advert Support</b> (contains examples of adverts and persuasive language and features) <b>Extension</b> Create a TV and/or radio advert to link in with your poster (ensuring you have a successful, cohesive campaign). If you have access to a computer or tablet, you could film your advertisement. Alternatively, you could perform it to your family/friends in person or on a video call.	<b>Remember to also include the logo and slogan for your ice cream brand.</b> You may also find this interesting - 'Football boot adverts through the decades'.
Spelling	<b>Bug Club (Grammar and Spelling Bug) - Silent Letters</b> Watch the video and play the games.	<b>Extension Ideas</b> - Pick a selection of the words from the games to learn. - Write 'odd sentences' like the one in the video containing words with silent letters.	In the second game, you will have to use capital letters if the words are proper nouns.
