

Spelling activities

Spellings are taught in a two-week block at school, so we recommend you use the same structure for your home-learning.

Week 1

- Lesson 1 Copy the new word list into the grid and write down the spelling rule.
Use the 'Look Cover Write Check' sheet to practise the new words.
- Lesson 2 Write the words in alphabetical order and then look up the definitions of 4 words of your choice.
- Lesson 3 Write the spelling words in a fun way, as described below (or any other ideas you might have):
