

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: Three Term: Autumn 1

English:

We are repeating Phase 5 Phonics for the first half term as a catch up in class.

- Spelling strategies: using Look / Cover / Write / Check to practise new spellings and other strategies such as saying it silly or silly sentences to remember unusual spellings.
- Revision of nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Book study – ‘The World’s Worst Children’.
- Planning and writing descriptions in connection to ‘The World’s Worst Children’
- Writing instructions linked to Eat Happy topic.

Maths:

- Place value with 3 and 4 digit numbers.
- Count forwards and backwards in ones, twos, tens and hundreds. Reading and writing large numbers and knowing the value of the digits.
- Group / order numbers of varying sizes.
- Mental arithmetic for addition and subtraction.
- Addition using a written method.

Science:

- Eat Happy – Food and nutrition.
- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition.
- Animals including humans cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- What is a diet?

Routine Homework:

- Fab Four reading challenge. Read together discussing the characters and plot. Fill in reading records together and return to school each Monday. Stickers make prizes!
- Revision of 2, 5, 10 times tables.

We will now be using google classroom to issue any homework. We will allocate tasks on websites such as My Maths and Bug Club.

Computing:

- Unfortunately, due to COVID19 we cannot at present deliver the IT curriculum via the computing suite. We will be including the use of iPads into our curriculum where possible.

Music and MFL:

- Online music lesson with Sheffield Music Hub.
- Greetings and classroom instructions.
- Animals and at the pet shop.
- Numbers and plurals.
- Connectives and simple sentences.

PSHE:

- Class Charter.
- How to be a good friend – based on The Rainbow Fish.
- Good to be me – building confidence during circle times based on a sense of self-esteem.
- Zones of regulation introduction.

PE:

- Outdoor – Tri-Golf
- Indoor – Badminton

Art & DT:

- Understand the colour wheel and how to blend colours.
