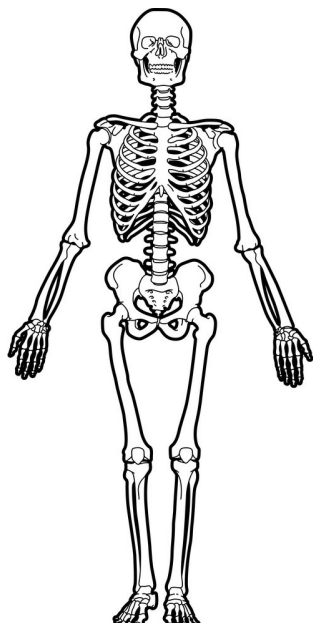

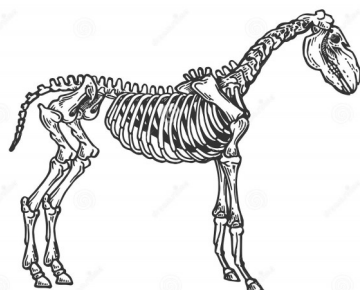
To know that human and animal skeletons:

Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Skeleton	An internal or external framework of bone
Muscle	Soft tissue found in most animals to produce force and motion
Vertebra	The 33 individual interlocking bones that form the spinal column
Spine	A series of vertebrae extending from the skull to the small of the back enclosing the spinal cord
Vertebrate	An animal with a spinal cord surrounded by cartilage or bone
Invertebrate	Animals that do not have a backbone or spine
Tempo	The speed of a piece of music
Dynamic	The musical term for volume—how loud or soft a sound is
Pitch	How high or low a sound is
