English:

- Posters and writing linked to looking after the oceans
- Using -es and -s to change the singular noun to plural.
- Sequencing linked to Someone swallowed Stanley.
- Writing descriptive sentences using conjunctions, time connectives and adjectives.

Maths:

- Place value and numbers to 50
