Torah	The holy book of Judaism read from right to left in a scroll.
Rabbi	The religious leader in the synagogue
Synagogue	The Jewish building where they worship.
Tallit	A fringed prayer shawl.
Kippah	A head covering worn by men during prayer.
Menorah	A sacred candelabrum with 8 branches used at Hanukkah.
Passover	A significant Jewish festival.
Hanukkah	A significant Jewish festival.
Kosher	The name given to food prepared in a particular way.
