

Prime Area: Communication & Language

- Begin to use subject specific vocabulary related to our topic such as past, present, root, stem (Please see our Knowledge Organiser)
- Use vocabulary to describe how they have changed since they were a baby and how a seedling changes and grows.
- Use imaginative language as part of play and past, present and future forms when talking about events that have happened or will happen in the future.

Prime Area: Personal Social and Emotional Development

- To understand how to be a good friend.
- To begin to understand that being reciprocal means being equal and fair.
- Take account of one another's ideas in play.
- Show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings.

Prime Area: Physical Development: Moving and Handling

- To practise how to create different gymnastic shapes.
- To practise jumping and rolling safely.

Prime Area: Physical Development: Health and Self Care

- Understand and talk about the ways we can stay healthy and safe e.g. physical exercise and a healthy diet.

Literacy: Reading

- Enjoy a range of stories related to Growth such as Titch.
- To develop confidence when reading phase 3 sounds in words.

Numeracy- Number

- Add and subtract single digit numbers.
- Double, halve and share amounts.
- Begin to recognise coins and their value.

- Music: Use voice and body to alter volume.
- Art: Pencil self-portrait and observational painting of a sunflower.
