- Begin to use subject specific vocabulary related to our topic such as environment, habitat, life-cycle, metamorphosis (Please see our Knowledge Organiser)
- To use language to describe minibeasts.
- To generate questions about minibeasts.
- To use imaginative language related to minibeasts.

Literacy: Reading

- Enjoy a range of stories related to minibeasts.
- To develop confidence when reading phase 3/4 sounds in words.

Literacy: Writing

- To retell the story of The Hungry Caterpillar.
- To write facts about minibeasts. To continue to spell words with phase 3/4 sounds and key words.

Prime Area: Personal Social and Emotional Development

- To talk about change and how it makes us feel.
- To talk about how we have changed since we started school.
- To talk about moving to Y1.
- To show respect, care and concern for living things and the environment.

Numeracy- Number

- To learn number bonds within 10 and 20.
- To subtract two single digit numbers.
- To use a number line to count back.
