Parental Conflict

Separated Parents Information Programme – 2x2 hours

This is a one off session and delivered over 2x 2 hour sessions This is for parents that are not within the court arena and delivered separately.

Family Transitions 6 weeks

Group programme for parents/carers who are experiencing personal stress from separation or divorce which is impacting or complicating Parenting.

Parents will come separately, however, this will be delivered parallel weekly for both parents To attend and receive the same information.

Being a Parent Together (BAPT- EPEC) 9 week programme

Father, mother and couple communication and assertiveness skills.

Mothers' and fathers' ability to constructively express, manage and resolve parental conflicts, particularly those directed at and involving the couple's children.

Improve relationship satisfaction and reduce the frequency and intensity of couple arguments.







Fathers/Male Carers Work

Dads/Male Carers impact their children's lives in all sorts of ways. Dads often offer a different style of learning/relationship with their children.

How do we work with Dads? Do Dads get invited to meetings? What questions are we asking? How confident do you feel contacting Dads/Step Dads/Carers who are no longer living at the family home?

Consultations can be requested and we would allocate one of the Male Parenting Practitioners.


New Parenting Pathways & Partnership Working




