Word	Definition
Ancient Rome	A historical period of time between 800BC to 476AD.
Empire	Where one country rules many other countries.
legionary	A soldier in the Roman army.
scutum	The shield used by legionaries.
aqueduct	A watercourse constructed to carry water.
Celts	A group of people who inhabited Britain at the time of the invasion.
mosaic	Floor or wall based art consisting of many coloured tiles.
gladiator	An armed fighter who would fight in public to entertain people.
chariot	A carriage pulled along by horses, often without a roof.
Caesar	One of the most well-known Roman leaders.
