

# Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: 2 Term: Autumn 1

## English:

- Learning what a sentence is and what it should include.
- Writing sentences about ourselves. Focusing on using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces.
- Writing riddles about woodland animals. Identifying and using verbs and adverbs.
- Writing a recount in the form of a diary entry of a person who witnessed the Great Fire of London. Focusing on writing in the past tense, using time adverbials and conjunctions.

## Maths:

### Place Value

- Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
- Partition 2-digit numbers in to tens and ones.
- Compare numbers and objects using greater/less than and equals signs
- Order numbers and objects

### Addition and subtraction

- Number bonds to 20
- Related number facts
- Add and subtract tens and ones from 2-digit numbers
- Add three 1 digit numbers

## Spelling and handwriting:

- Correct formation of all letters (print).
- Spelling Y1 and Y2 common exception words.
- j sound spelt g/ ge/dge
- n sound spelt kn/gn
- r sound spelt wr
- ly suffix for adverbs
- Adding vowel suffixes ing, ed, er, est and y
- Recap phase 5 sounds

## Computing:

- What is a computer?  
Looking at the components of a computer, using key word internet searches and the importance of passwords.

## Music:

- Music appreciation – listening to pieces of music and discussing as a class.
- Composing a piece of music of their interpretation of the Great Fire of London.
