

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: Three Term: Autumn 1

English:

- Spelling strategies: using Look / Cover / Write / Check to practise new spellings and other strategies such as saying it silly or silly sentences to remember unusual spellings.
- Revision of nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Book study – ‘The World’s Worst Children’.
- Planning and writing descriptions in connection to ‘The World’s Worst Children’
- Writing instructions linked to Eat Happy topic.

Maths:

- Place value with 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Count forwards and backwards in ones, twos, tens and hundreds.
- Reading and writing large numbers and knowing the value of the digits.
- Group / order numbers of varying sizes.
- Mental arithmetic for addition and subtraction.
- Addition using a written method.

Science:

- Eat Happy – Food and nutrition.
- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition.
- Animals including humans cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- What is a diet?

Routine Homework:

- Read together at least 4 times a week discussing the characters and plot. Fill in reading records together.

Please bring reading books and records to school every day.

- Number bonds and times tables. Google classroom will be used to allocate weekly homework.

Computing:

- Word processing skills, using a range of Google software to create pupil profiles.

Music and MFL:

- Percussion lessons with Sheffield Music Hub.
- Singing linked to PSHE
- Greetings and classroom instructions.
- Animals and at the pet shop.
- Numbers and plurals.
- Connectives and simple sentences.

PSHE:

- Class Charter.
- How to be a good friend
- Good to be me – building confidence during circle times based on a sense of self-esteem.
- Zones of regulation introduction.

Dates:

- Parents Evening – 5th/7th October
- Nasal flu vaccination for Y3 (date to be confirmed)

PE:

- Outdoor – Netball
- Indoor – Ball Skills

Art & DT:

- Exploring form and shape in relation to woodland animals.
- Creating texture with pencils.
- Tonal qualities of colour and monotoes.
- Art therapy mindfulness.
