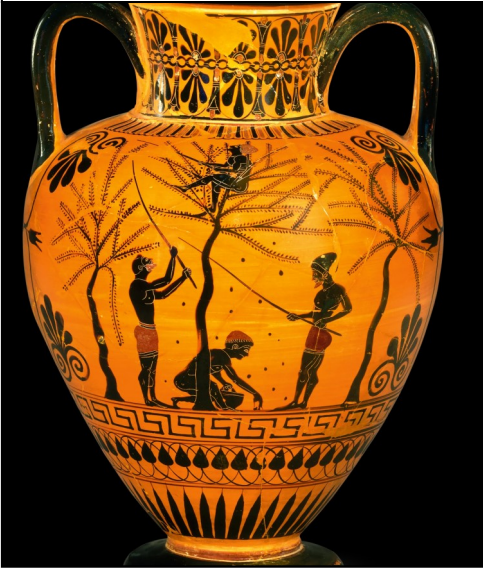


Ancient Greece (History) ~ Y5

architecture	The design and construction of buildings
democracy	People having a say in how their country is run
legacy	Ideas handed down by a previous civilization
civilization	An advanced system of human society
myth	A traditional story involving creation or gods and goddesses
government	A group of people who lead a country
influence	An ability to change someone's mind or behaviour
philosophy	Asking big questions about the meaning of life
City state	A mini country the size of a city
