English:

Key text - Somebody Swallowed Stanley

- Posters and writing linked to looking after the oceans
- Using -es and -s to change the singular noun to plural.
- Sequencing linked to Somebody swallowed Stanley.
- Write sequenced sentences linked to the key text.
- Writing descriptive sentences using conjunctions, time connectives and adjectives.

Maths: Addition and subtraction within 20

- Add and subtract using a ten frame.
- Add using dienes tens and ones.
- Add and subtract numbers within 20 using a number line.

Numbers/place value to 50

- Represent and recognise numbers using tens and ones.
- Find one more/one less.
- Order and compare numbers to 50 referring to the tens and ones.

Science:

- Observe changes through the seasons.
- Observe and describe the weather linked to these seasons.
- Discuss how the length of the day is changing.

- Oceans - name and locate the world's five oceans. QR codes linked with computing. Bee Bots to navigate around. Use of real globe to label oceans. Learn why oceans are important, what pollutes them and how we can make changes to save our planet.
