

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: 1 Term: Summer 1

English:

Key Text – Jack and the Beanstalk

- Introduce the prefix –un to show opposites.
- Use exclamation marks to show expression when writing.
- Compare different versions of Jack and the Beanstalk.
- Write a version of Jack of the Beanstalk changing key parts.

Phonics – Recap reading and writing phase 3, 4 and 5 sounds with a focus on independently recognising digraphs and blends in words.

Maths:

Multiplication and Division Counting in 2's and 5's. - Make equal groups, Add equal groups using repeated addition, Show multiplication using arrays, Show division as sharing, Show division as grouping, Doubling numbers.

Fractions - Find half/quarter of a shape, Find half/quarter of a quantity.

Position and direction- Describe position using the correct language, Introduce and understand turns quarter, half three quarter, whole).

Science:

- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Drama/Music :

- Jack and the beanstalk retell - use of different voices to act out the story.
- Kickstart to music - Sounds and invention

Computing:

Creating media – digital painting

Learners will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. They then use these tools to create their own digital paintings,

PSHCE:

Community - How do we make a happy school.

Understand why we have rules to help us be happy. Appreciate how special school is and the important people within school.
