

Parent SEND Survey - April 2022



A big thank you to all the parents of children on the SEN register who completed the recent SEND Parent Survey. We really appreciate you taking the time to give us feedback on what's going well and could be better.

Parents were asked to rate statements on a scale of 1-5 (a score of 4 or 5 indicates a positive score)

I'd like to share with you the results...

- 100% of parents gave a positive response for 'The school values the views, wishes and feelings of children',
- 100% of parents gave a positive response for 'The school values the views, wishes and feelings of parents'
- 100% of parents gave a positive response for 'My child's needs are well supported at school'
- 100% of parents gave a positive response for 'I am able to express my views in SEN review meetings and feel like I am working in partnership with the school to support my child',
- 95% of parents gave a positive response for 'My child is happy at school'
- 89% of parents gave a positive response for 'My child is making good progress at school'.

There were some lovely comments about what is going well including;

- Feel very well supported for both our child and as parents and all staff are very approachable.
- Always responsive to any issues or concerns.
- Provision is of a high standard.
- Our child is extremely well catered for.
- Communication and listening to my child
- You know the children and support them in a bespoke fashion that makes it just right for their individual needs.
- We are delighted and really grateful for all the support we receive for both our children.

There was also useful feedback on what could be improved further including;

- To be able to go back into school so we could visit the wonderful sunflower room.
- Use of equipment and software to enhance learning.
- Ensuring no child sits a practise paper which is too challenging for them.

The results indicate that our aims are largely being realised; parents and school working together in partnership to meet the needs of the whole child.

We are proud of our inclusive culture, relationships with parents, our passion for getting things right for the children. We are continually trying to improve things further and in the academic year 22-23 we plan to further develop; pupil voice through new one page profiles, embed new assessment tools leading to tighter targets, further develop quality first teaching methods and the use of IT in supporting a range of needs and introducing precision teaching techniques.
