

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: 2 Term: Spring 2 - 6 weeks

English:

- Book Study: Ghanaian Goldilocks by Dr Tamara Polozi and Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown – can we finish reading Flat Stanley next week?.
- Traditional tales – children will look at the tale of the 3 Little Pigs and the Ghanaian Goldilocks and look at how traditional tales can be modified depending on different cultures.
- Children will create their own African version of the 3 Little Pigs (linking to our Topic work).
- Recounts – we will look at the features of recounts and children will write a recount of their trip to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park.

Maths:

- **Money** – value of money, calculations using money, using money in a shop, change - 2 weeks
- **Length and height** - measure, compare and order length - 2 weeks
- **Mass, Capacity and Temperature** – measure, weigh, compare and order - 2 weeks
- **Home tasks could include;**
Shopping and using coins to pay for chosen items, cooking to measure ingredients and liquids, looking at the weather forecast over a week to look at temperature

Topic:

Africa

- Name the continents and Oceans. Locate Africa on a map
- Compare Africa to England. Including:
 - Climate
 - Culture/schools
 - landscape
- African habitats and wildlife

Spelling and handwriting:

- Forming all letters correctly
- Beginning to join letters
- 'o' saying /u/ as in worry, son, above
- 'ey' saying /ee/ as in key, money
- Contractions such as isn't, can't
- 'war' saying /wur/ as in warm
- Adding suffixes -ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y

Computing:

Presenting data – children to look at tally charts and pictograms and how we can use technology to present these.
Online Safety.

Music:

- Music appreciation – listening to a piece of music and discussing how it makes them feel
- Singing
- Carnival of the Animals

- Money Matters – 3 sessions on how we use money and how everything we buy has a price. How we afford things and how we save.
