Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased to announce that in support of the topic, 'Stone Age Bone Age', we will be taking Year 3 pupils to visit Creswell Crags. This visit has enhanced the children's understanding of life in the Stone Age for many years. We will be visiting the caves to hear stories about life during this period and doing some archaeological discovery of our own!

The trip will take place on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023** and all children will need to bring a **packed lunch, drink and snack**.
