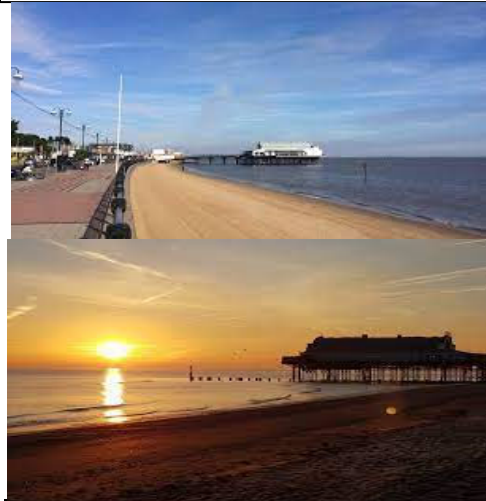

Word	Definition
map	A pictorial representation of an area of land.
county	An area of a country managed by a local government, e.g. South Yorkshire.
human feature	Features made by humans.
physical feature	Features which are natural and would be here without people.
land use	The human use of land.
landmark	An object or a feature of a landscape or town.
Economic activity	The way in which goods and services are made, sold and used in an area.
