## Key Vocabulary

Definition

Root

The part of a plant which attaches it to the ground or to a support .

Stem

The main body or stalk of a plant or shrub .

Leaf

A flattened structure of a higher plant, typically green and blade-like, that is attached to a stem directly or via a stalk. Leaves are the main

Petal

Each of the segments of the corolla of a flower, which are modified

Flower

The seed-bearing part of a plant, consisting of reproductive organs .

Deciduous

A tree that sheds its leaves annually.

Evergreen

A tree that retains green leaves throughout the year.

Trunk

The main woody stem of a tree as distinct from its branches and roots.

Branch

A part of a tree which grows out from the trunk.
