We have a wide range of extra curricular clubs on offer each week at Ecclesall Primary, meeting the needs of all our children. We are confident that there is something for everyone.

Some club's fees will be added to parentpay (KS2 Choir, Dance, recorder & ping pong). If you are entitled to Pupil Premium funding (free school meals) please also get in touch as we may be able to assist with arrangements for your child/children to attend a club.


We have attached a list of all the clubs that are going to be available next term (Spring 2024) which includes a few changes to those offered last term:
