	Yom Kippur	A Jewish festival to say sorry and ask for forgiveness.
g	Pesach	A Jewish festival to remember the escape from slavery.
	Commandment	A rule that Jewish people believe that they must follow as it is commanded by God.
	Sadar	A Jewish meal that has been eaten for thousands of years
