Word	Definition
Invasion	An instance of invading a country or region with an armed.
Power	The capacity or ability to direct or influence the behaviour of others or the course of events.
Society	A grouping of people having common traditions, institutions, and collective activities and interests.
Dictator	A ruler with total power over a country, typically one who has obtained control by force.
Air raid	The individual bombing raids onto British cities undertaken by the Luftwaffe (German air force).
Ration	The set amount of food each person was allowed during the war as food supplies were limited.
The Blitz	The intense bombing campaign undertaken by Nazi Germany against the United Kingdom during WW2 (Sept 1940-May 1941).
Evacuation	Means to leave a place. Many children living in big cities were moved temporarily from their homes to places considered safer.
