Dear Parents/Carers


We are delighted to be able to offer a new music club to children in Y2 – Y6. Ben Bartholomew (our current guitar teacher and Sheffield Music Hub Lead teacher) will be offering a Ukulele club from after the half-term holiday. The club will take place on a Tuesday morning from 8.15 – 8.45 and be held in the Garden Room (by the Y6 classrooms). This club is suitable for beginners and more experienced players. It will improve general musical skills, musicianship, collaboration (playing together), performance opportunities and hopefully a lot of fun.

It is suggested that members of the club should have their own ukulele. Starter instruments can be purchased relatively inexpensively and owning your own instrument means that the children will be able to do a little practice at home between club sessions (as well as share their learning with families)! We will have a few instruments that can be borrowed for the club, although it is expected that these will be shared.

The cost of this club will be £3.50/week and payment in half term blocks will be added to parent pay.
