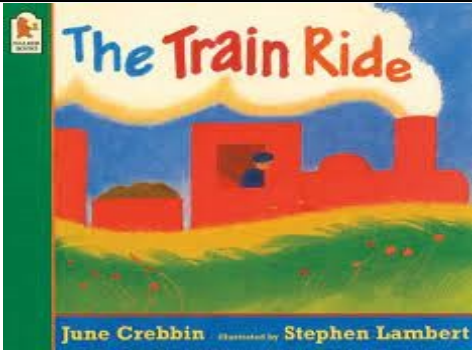


YR Journeys - Spring 2

Urban	An area where many people live and work close together e.g. towns and cities.
Rural	An area that has few homes and buildings and not very many people e.g. countryside and villages.
Feature	Something you can see in the environment.
Direction	The position towards which we move or face.
Route	A way or direction between places.
