

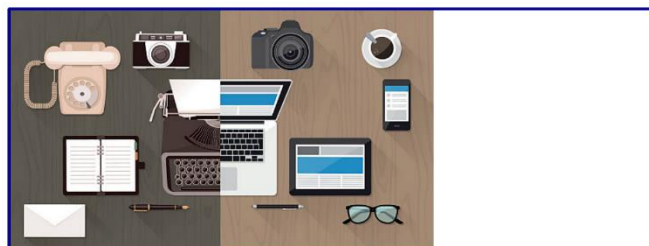
## National Science Week 11<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024

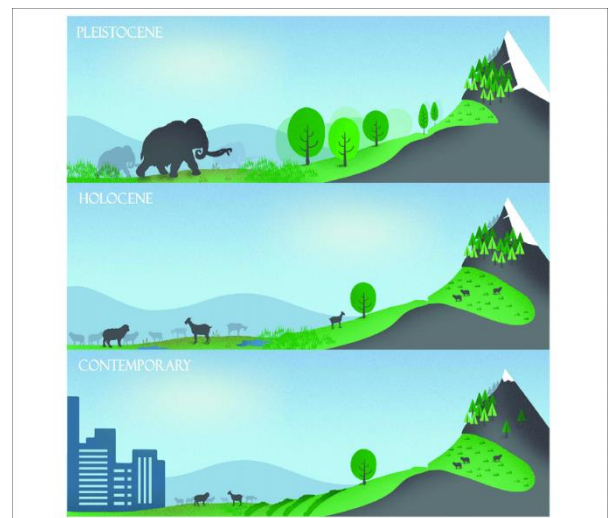
Here are some ideas to get the children's brains working:
