Dear Parents/Carers of Year 3,

We are very pleased to announce that in support of the topic, 'Beside the Seaside', we will be taking Year 3 pupils on a visit to Cleethorpes! This visit will give the pupils the opportunity to enhance their geographical skills as we compare a coastal town with our locality and practise some map skills.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday**, **2**nd **July** and all children will need to bring **a packed lunch**, **drink and snack {no nuts}**. They will need to wear clothing and footwear suitable for outdoor activities but we ask that they wear a school sweatshirt and bring a coat.

We will need children to come to school for 8.00am on the day of the trip so that we can set off promptly at 8.15am. We will set off back from Cleethorpes at approximately 1:45pm and will return to school between 3.30pm and 4.00pm, however we may be slightly late, depending on the traffic.

We would be grateful if you could send a contribution of £17.27 to cover the cost of the visit. This cost includes the coach journey and a return trip on the land train along the promenade. School will be purchasing every child an ice lolly – please see your class teacher if you have any concerns about allergies.

We also kindly ask that your child brings an additional £3.00 on the day in a labelled purse, wallet or envelope. As part of the day, we will be visiting a souvenir shop so that the children can purchase an item of their choice. This will support the work that we will be doing as part of our 'Money Matters' curriculum. If you have any further questions, please see your class teacher.
