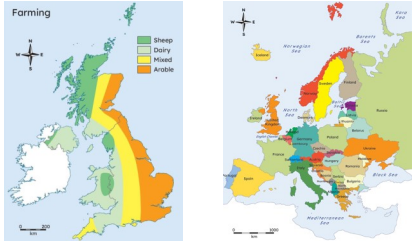


# Year 3 Farming in the UK and Europe



## End Points:

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## Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
agriculture	The science or industry of cultivating soil and farming including growing crops and rearing animals for food.
arable farming	The growing of crops for food on farms e.g. wheat
livestock farming	The rearing of animals for food on farms e.g. dairy
rural settlements	Found in the countryside surrounded by open land
land use	The function or use of a particular area e.g. for farming
farmer	Someone who grows plants and raises animals for food or raw materials.
climate	The weather found in a place over a long period of time.
trade	The buying and selling of goods and services.
season	The cycle of weather changes. The 4 seasons are spring, summer autumn and winter.
