English:

Stories -Hansel and Gretel and The Gruffalo

Poetry week with Conrad Burdekin

Write simple sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Understand what a sentence is. Write simple sentences including adjectives or verbs.

Phonics - Recap level 3 and 4 phonics. Introduce level 5 phonics.

Maths: Numbers to 10 / addition and subtraction within 10

- Count out a number of objects accurately and Match a group of objects to the correct number.
- Represent numbers in different ways.
- Find one more/less than a number
- Compare numbers
- Count forwards/backwards
- Explore missing number sequences
- Find number bonds within 10.
- Use the part part whole mode, ten frame, bead string and number line to show addition.

Science: Plants and seasons

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants
- Identify and name a variety deciduous and evergreen trees
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
- Recognise signs of autumn and discuss changes in weather.

Geography:

- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language
- I can use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of my school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environments.

Computing: Develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. Learners will also consider how to use technology responsibly.

PHSE /RSE: Discuss classroom expectations and create a class contract for a happy classroom.

- Discussion questions linked to Hansel and Gretel.
- Family - Whos in my family? Do families always stay the same? How should families treat each other?

RE:

Pupils will learn about the Christian creation story. They will learn about the key events within the story and be able to retell it using key vocabulary. They will begin to understand that some Christians believe different things about creation.
