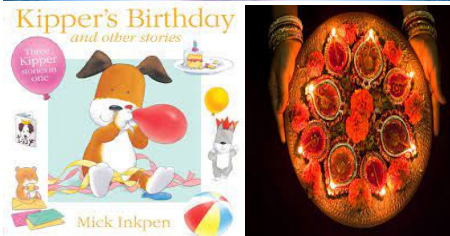


YR Our Community and Celebrations Around the World - Autumn 2
