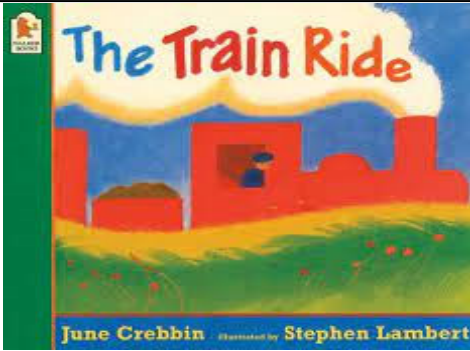

Destination	The place where you are going.
Environment	The places and things around where we live.
Map	A picture used to help us find our way around different places.
Urban	An area where many people live and work close together e.g. towns and cities.
Rural	An area that has few homes and buildings and not very many people e.g. countryside and villages.
Natural feature	A natural feature is something that has grown such as a tree flower or grass.
Human feature	A human feature is something that a person has made such as bench park or building.
