



I am delighted to let you know that 'Mini Musicians' will be returning to Ecclesall Primary School after summer half term for children in EYFS and KS1.

This half term, we have covered a variety of musical elements in a fun way! We have **played**: Boomwhackers, handbells, cup drums and untuned percussion instruments. We have **listened** to a wide range of musical genres from classical to pop. We have learnt about famous composers, **moved** in time to the beat and used our bodies as percussion instruments. But most importantly, we've had lots of FUN!

'Mini Musicians' sessions are music-based and are designed around the Early Years and KS1 music curriculum. They are relaxed and no prior musical knowledge is required. They are run by a qualified primary school teacher and music lead.

The sessions are on Wednesdays straight after school until 4.20pm. They will cost £5.50 per child, per week and bookings will be taken for the whole half term (£44.00).

The cost for the club next half term will be £44.00 per child, non-refundable and payable before the sessions begin.
