



'Mini Musicians', is a fun, after-school music club for children run by a qualified primary school teacher. It is currently run in several Sheffield schools, including Ecclesall Primary School. From September, we will be opening the doors for children in Year 3 to join us as well.

In our sessions we cover: listening, responding, singing, composing, notation and performing together as an ensemble. We learn about lots of different music genres, from classical to pop (These are all elements of the Music curriculum).

We will learn how to play tuned (handbells, Boomwhackers etc) and untuned instruments together (cup drums, percussion instruments etc).

'Mini Musicians' sessions are always relaxed and FUN and no prior musical knowledge is required.

From September, Mini Musicians will be returning to Ecclesall Primary School on **Thursdays** straight after school until 4.20pm for all children in Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3. They will cost £5.50 per child, per week and bookings will be taken for the whole half term (7 weeks). The total cost will be £38.50 per child.

The first session will be on Thursday 11th September and the last one will be Thursday 23rd October.
