Ecclesall Primary School is a friendly, happy and creative school. Our motto is "Happy Children, Happy School, Learning together, Growing together". From the very start of their time at Ecclesall Primary School children know that their happiness and well-being is our priority. Our three Ecclesall values are Positivity, Kindness and Respect. We have had seven very successful years in our primary school with lots of new facilities including 15 new classrooms, a studio and class kitchen, a large library in the Atrium, a larger dining room and kitchen, small year group rooms as an extension of the classrooms, a MUGA (Multi use games area), an Ecclesall Hub, an additional playground for our younger children, various hub rooms including the Searoom, The Den, Sunflower room, Leopards room and Jungle room, Teachers' PPA room and two trim trails, one on both playgrounds. We have extensive grounds with a large wildlife area behind EYFS/Y1 area with an ECO greenhouse, pavilion and seating area and a community wildlife area.

We have colourful playground markings on both playgrounds. We are very proud of our school awards including our Green Flag with distinction 2025, Excellent Active Travel Modeshift stars award 2025, Silver award for KS1 Sports, Gold award for KS2 Sports amongst others.

We work in close partnership and feel very well supported by our parents through the Ecclesall Parents Teachers Friends Association, our Governors, the staff at Ecclesall Primary School and our local community including our local schools nearby. We are part of SWIP (South West Improving Partners) where 12 local schools work closely together sharing very good practice. We also work closely with schools in Peak Edge Academy and with other local schools about to join Peak Edge in the next year.

Our Parents and Carers are always welcome at Ecclesall Primary School. We have an open door policy and pride ourselves on our friendly, welcoming ethos. We look forward to meeting you and your child. We hope that you find our school website useful and informative.

SCHOOL DAY start and end times

Parking outside of school

As you are aware, we continue to work with Living Streets and Modeshift stars re ACTIVE TRAVEL. This Summer 2025, we achieved Distinction for our Green Flag once again and Excellent status for our Modeshift Stars award for Active travel. We use the WOW Living Streets daily tracker encouraging the children to walk, scooter, bike, skip, or park and stride to school. We have many children who ride a scooter or bike to school and use the cycle store on our large playground. Please ask your child about Active Travel as they take it very seriously and know that they help our school and community by educating their own families.

Reminder:

Please do not park on double yellow lines, across driveways, in bus stops, on pavements outside of school or blocking the line of site for children and families crossing the road. Please park considerately to ensure the safety of all our children and our local community.

We will be appointing new Y6 Junior Road Safety Officers (JRSOs) once again who will be working closely with our ECO team and Senior Leadership Team to ensure everyone's safety.

Punctuality

School begins at 8.45. Any children arriving at school after 8.50am will be late and must be signed in at the main school office to ensure the correct dinner arrangements are made for them.

ILLNESS, APPOINTMENTS, ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Telephone calls will be answered in the office from 8.15am every day.

SICKNESS - We follow the Health Protection Agency guidance which states that, to stop the spread of sickness and diarrhoea, children must not return to school until 48 hours have passed since the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. We appreciate your understanding with this.

Medicines

We cannot give any unprescribed paracetamol such as Calpol or other tablets unless prescribed by a doctor. You will need to fill in a Medicine form at the office giving permission for a dosage at 12pm for prescribed medication.

PE KIT

All children come to school wearing their PE Kits on PE days. Please wear white or blue tops and dark shorts /joggers /leggings and school hoodies only.

No Mobile phones policy

We have a strict no mobile phones policy in school whether an adult or child (this includes our parents and carers). Please respect this policy.

Y5/6 pupils need permission from the Head Teacher if bringing their phones into school. They will be securely locked away during school hours in the school office. Children cannot use their phones walking in or out of the school grounds. Phones can be switched on once **off** site. Thank you.

FS and KS1 SCHOOL MEALS

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to a free school meal. Children will choose what they are having for lunch the night before with their parent or during morning registration using Parent Pay.

We are a healthy school and work closely with Eat Smart Sheffield. This is a school based programme focussing on food and nutrition. They support families to help encourage children and young people to develop healthy lifestyle habits so they can grow, thrive and live life to the full.

PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS

Please inform the class teacher/office in the morning when you drop off your child if they will be going home with another parent or carer/adult.

NO DOGS

Unless there is a special dog event, we have a no dogs policy on our Ecclesall Primary school site. Also please do not leave your dog tied up at either school entrance. These are for health and safety reasons. Some of our children are frightened of dogs.
