Dear Y3 Parents/Carers,

The children in Y3 will be making Christingles in school during the week of 8th December. Please could all children bring an orange into school by Wednesday 10th December. The Christingles will also contain vegan friendly jelly tot sweets (see allergy information below) that school will provide.

Allergy Information



Fruit flavoured jelly sweets
Ingredients: Sugar, Glucose syrup, Starch, Acids (Malic acid, Citric acid, Lactic acid), Concentrated fruit juices (Apple, Blackcurrant, Orange, Strawberry, Lemon), Acidity regulator (Trisodium citrate), Flavourings, Colours (Anthocyanins, Copper complexes of chlorophyllins, Beta-carotene, Curcumin). **Important:** Young children (less than 4 years) have limited chewing ability and could choke on small sweets.
