

# Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: 2 Term: Summer 2

**English:** This half term we will be looking in depth at 'Traditional tales' such as 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and many more.

We will learn about the features of these stories and the familiar patterned language in each.

Children will write their own version of a traditional tale using conjunctions, correct punctuation, time adverbials and expanded noun phrases.

- SPaG- Y2 common exception words and rules. Sentence types with correct punctuation.
- Comprehension: Focus on identifying specific points in the text where ideas are discussed (including non-fiction texts).
- Letter writing linked to transition. With a focus on using Y2 writing skills.

## Maths:

Shape and Geometry:

- Recognising and drawing 2D and 3D shapes
- Counting sides and vertices on 2D shapes
- Drawing vertical lines of symmetry
- Completing shapes using reflective symmetry
- Counting vertices and edges on 3D Shapes

- Statistics - collecting and interpreting data
- Position and direction - understanding left, right, above, Below.
- Clockwise and anti-clockwise
- Quarter, half and full turns

- Name the continents and Oceans. Locate Africa on a map
- Compare Africa to England. Including:
  - Climate
  - Culture/schools
  - landscape
  - African habitats and wildlife

- Days of the week
- Months of the year
