Dear Parent/Carers,

We are very much looking forward to our trip on Monday and are making the final preparations. We are in no rush to set off as we only have a short journey to our destination so please come to the bottom area of the car park between 9:00 and 9:10am and place your child's luggage into the area set aside for their class.
