

Ecclesall Primary School Curriculum Overview Year: Three Term: Autumn 1

English: Using spelling strategies to practise new spellings for example: saying it silly or silly sentences to remember unusual spellings. Revision of word classes. Revision of sentence structure using word building strategies. Writing a character description based on Charlotte's Web. Writing instructions linked to making a spooky sandwich. Maths: Place value with 2- and 3-digit numbers. Count forwards and backwards in ones, twos, tens and hundreds. Reading and writing large numbers and knowing the value of the digits. Group and order numbers of varying sizes. Mental arithmetic for addition and subtraction. Addition using a written method.	Music and MFL: Percussion lessons with Sheffield Music Hub. Sequencing music – see computing Greetings and classroom instructions. Animals and at the pet shop. Numbers and plurals. European Day of Languages.	Art & DT: Exploring form and shape in relation to self portraits. Creating texture with pencils. Designing and making a healthy sandwich.
Science: Food and nutrition. Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition. Animals including humans cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. Exploring healthy food choices	Routine Homework: Read together 4 times a week discussing the characters and plot. Fill in reading records together. Practise class spellings for fortnightly quiz. Please bring reading books and records to school every day. Time tables practice. Google classroom will be used to allocate homework.	PSHE/R.E: How to be a good friend?
